**Item 1** **Welcome/ Introduction** **Peter York**  
Mr. York welcomed everyone to the October 2006 SAC meeting.

**Item 2** **Minutes Review and Corrections** **Peter York**

**Item 4** **Laptop Self Insurance Fund** **Connie Collins**  
Dr. Collins provided clarification of last month's discussion on the laptop insurance. She read from the School Board minutes where the fee was adopted. The language clearly states that it is a laptop self-insure fund. The \$50 fee is sent to the school district and held in the county risk fund. The self-insure pool is then used for the replacement of laptop computers that are stolen, lost, or damaged beyond repair. The school board adoption of this self-insure fund also states the parent's must pay a \$100 deductible when filing a claim.
