Eligibility

- Be a high school senior
- Have an overall grade point average of 2.5 or greater
- Have been accepted or applied to an accredited college/university
- Submit an official transcript and application

Award and Deadline Summary

Crooms AOIT Alumni Community Scholarship: One (1) \$500 scholarship will be awarded.

The scholarship should be used for the purpose of tuition and/or college related expenses. Deadline for application is May 16th, 2008. The scholarship recipient will be notified before graduation.

All application materials must be submitted electronically (via e-mail) to Mrs. Alper by May 16, 2008 in order to be considered for the scholarship. Please scan your transcript for submission; scanners are available throughout the school for your use.

By submitting this application the applicant hereby certifies all information contained within is factual and as accurate as possible. The applicant also agrees to allow a selection committee, which may include Crooms Alumni, to review all submitted material. The utmost effort will be taken to review the submitted material in a way that protects the applicant from any bias, which may include (but is not limited to): the blacking out of names on the application, using a review process that assigns applications a random number for anonymity, and so-forth.
